BIO

Isobel is an award-winning songsmith based in London UK. Isobel blends her love for Wistful Americana and Country music to create a unique lyric-based sound. Influences include Bonnie Raitt, Eva Cassidy, Sheryl Crow and Brad Paisley.

Isobel's self-penned songs have given her a wide range of success singing all over the UK and internationally in venues such as the **O2 Shepherd's Bush Empire** – where she performed her song 'I Won't' which was **winner** of the Tech Music Schools (BIMM London) 'Song of The Year' as well as: **Rampelyset, Denmark, Broadstairs Blues Bash, Swanage Blues Festival, Ain't Nothin' But The Blues Bar, Soho, The Troubadour, London and Ground Zero Blues Club in the USA**. This has given Isobel a chance to build her reputation and hone her skills.

This has also led to Isobel being a nominee in the GSMC Awards in both 20/21 for 'Best Female Artist' as well as being a Category Finalist in the **Blues & Roots Radio** International Songwriting Competition 20/21 with her song 'More Than Words' and in 22/23 with her song 'Wings.'



Isobel independently released her Debut EP '*Keeping On*' in 2013, which was recorded with Curved Air legend – Michael Wedgwood at his studios in Denmark. This received radio interest from not only local radio stations but also BBC Introducing UK – the South. This was followed by Isobel's E.P '*On My Own*.' On My Own was launched at a sold-out ticketed event in Wiltshire and also at the infamous Bedford in Balham. Isobel also performed tracks from the E.P live on BBC Wiltshire, and it has had nationwide airplay. The record has been described by **Rock-Regeneration** as: *"a plethora of blues influences as well as a good sprinkling of country styles with Isobel's fine vocals being the proverbial cherry on the cake."*

Isobel released her single '*Walking Down The Tracks*' in October 2020 which is described as a Blues tinged Americana track detailing the troubles of continuing something despite being unquestionably bad news. This has been featured on radio stations such as: Blues & Roots Radio, **Country Hits UK (Absolute Radio Country)**, BBC Wiltshire and many more.

In 2021 & 2022 Isobel released her latest singles '*Forget*' & '*Wings*' recorded at Tunnel Rat Studios in Salisbury with Guitarist and Producer Jolyon Dixon (The Who, Pete Townsend, Toyah, Judie Tzuke) who also features on 'Wings' and both have since seen nationwide airplay.
